- Las Vegas was chosen to give us a chance to have an early reunion in a new, fun and accessible place with abundant sunshine where we can escape the cold winter weather!
- In addition to providing access to all the fun on the Las Vegas Strip and basin, Sunset Station has many amenities on the premises including several nice restaurants, a dozen movie theaters and a bowling alley. There is great shopping across the street.
- Following the lead of the Class of '60 at their 55th reunion in June, we will invite other classes who attended school with us ('59, '60, '62 and '63). Everyone is also welcome to bring family members as has been done in the past.
- ***We want to get the initial word out now so you can make travel and hotel reservations right away. To reserve your rooms: 1) call the Sunset Station Reservation Office at (888)786-7389, ask for "reservations" and give the OFFER CODE: SCI55TH. You can then book a room for \$39 per night (with tax and hotel service fee included @ \$57 per night), or 2) book on line at <http://sunsetstation.sclv.com/hotel> using the same OFFER CODE and following the prompts (putting offer code in the "Offer Code" box; clicking on "Book Now!"; selecting date of arrival [March 27], number of nights [3] and room type [King or Double-Queen] and then clicking "Get Rate". You will be asked to provide a credit card and pay for the first night. A room can be canceled with 72 hours notice without penalty.
- We will have a full-time hospitality suite at Sunset Station where we can relax and mingle throughout the reunion. There will be a buffet dinner/"dance to the ("our") music" on Monday night, March 28, in a ballroom at the Sunset Station. We are considering other activities as well, but want to leave plenty of time to simply enjoy each other and Las Vegas.
